# Victims of Our Own De-Vices

"We are all just prisoners here of our own device ... "

The Eagles' 1976 hit song "Hotel California" is known for its dark and troubling lyrics about stopping on the dangerous road of human vice. Most people who heard it on the radio in '76 didn't need to take a class on the vices to know what "being prisoners of our own device" was all about.

Vice is an ancient, Christian word. Taken from Latin for *defect, imperfection, or impediment*, vice lists or categories of sin became a powerful tool for followers of Jesus recognize their daily "falling short of the ry of God." (Romans 3:23)



Historically numbering from seven to nine es, and their antidote virtues, these teaching

tools have been around from the time of early-church theologian Tertullian (c. 200 AD) to Lutheran pastor Martin Chemnitz (c. 1550 AD) Vice lists continue to guide Christian pilgrims on the narrow way of following the law of Christ.

In January and February of 2025 at Allen Avenue CRC, we're going to learn from the story of Israel in Exodus, Leviticus, and Numbers. And their vices will be on full display, revealing to us our own. We'll look at how "these things occurred as examples to keep us from setting our hearts on evil things as they did...and were written down as warnings for us, on whom the culmination of the ages has come." (1 Cor. 10:6 & 11)

The challenge of paying attention to our vices will be twofold:

we can become preoccupied with vice's temptations and neglect the virtues we can become desensitized to vice's effects and end up minimizing their harms

Yet, thanks be to God, we have been saved so that we die to sin and live by grace alone through faith! It is through the virtue of Christ Jesus that we can be led by the Holy Spirit to live virtuous-ly.

Paul's words in Romans 6:11-14 will prove timely: "In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires. Do not offer any part of yourself to sin as an instrument of wickedness, but rather offer yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer every part of yourself to him as an instrument of righteousness. For sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law, but under grace law of Christ.
